

# East Middle School Citizenship

## ***O – Outstanding***

- Always controls self
- Never distracted by others
- Always follows directions the first time
- Always arrives with supplies and shares them
- Participates in class discussions and encourages others to do the same
- Good listener
- Ready to start
- Never tardy
- Works above and beyond expectations
- Does extra work without being asked to
- Makes sure he or she understands, asks good questions
- Never disrupts class
- Goes out of their way to help other students understand and stay on task
- Attitude – *“I am here to get the best education I can. How can I do my best to help others do the same?”*

## ***G- Good***

- Generally in control of self
- Not distracted by others
- Follows directions the first time
- Arrives with supplies
- Participates in class discussions
- Good listener
- Ready to start
- Never tardy
- Usually participates in class discussions
- Willing to do extra work
- Attempt to make sure he or she understands
- Never disrupts class
- Usually goes out of their way to help other students understand and stay on task
- Attitude – *“I am here to pay attention and learn.”*

## ***S – Satisfactory***

- Occasionally has to be reminded to pay attention
- Always ready to work
- Has supplies
- Follows directions the first time
- Occasionally participates in class discussions
- Seldom goes out of the way to help others understand and behave
- Doesn't cause distractions
- Is sometimes distracted by others
- Attitude – *“Sometimes like a G, sometimes like an NI.”*

## ***N – Needs Improvement***

- Usually polite to the teacher and other students
- Often behaves in silly ways
- Talking out of turn
- Not respecting other's property
- Does not participate in class discussions
- Often has good days
- Usually does what is told, but needs to be reminded frequently
- Always stops behavior when reminded
- Attitude – *“The teacher is the boss, but I haven't done anything wrong until I am caught.”*

## ***U – Unsatisfactory***

- Frequently interrupts class
- Does not always stop behavior when asked
- Often unprepared for class
- Negative to other students or the teacher
- Tends not to take responsibility for own behavior
- Blames teacher or other students for behavior or academic shortfall
- May show attitude through habitual unexcused tardiness or absence
- Attitude – *“I go to school because my parents make me and to see my friends. It's the teacher's job to make me work and behave.”*
